

## Printing with the LCS

The Lane Control System is a text based program, and requires a text printer to print score sheets. Suitable printers include:

- Dot matrix type printers, with either no driver or the generic windows text driver
- Laser printers that support PCL code, with their own DOS compatible driver
- Any printer with a DOS compatible driver.

It is becoming increasingly difficult to find these types of printers. An alternate solution is to use a utility like DOSPRN, which allows the LCS to print to ANY windows compatible printer.

To use DOSPRN, first download it from [www.dosprn.com](http://www.dosprn.com) and install it on the LCS computer. A small fee is payable for DOSPRN (around \$US15). Ensure your windows printer is installed correctly and works from within windows.

For the DOS LCS, no additional configuration is needed. By default DOSPRN captures LPT1, and this is the default port for LCS printing.

For the Windows LCS, in System Configuration enter the printer port as c:\prnspl. This is the default capture file for DOSPRN. Also ensure the Windows LCS is version 7.15 or later.

It is also possible to use DOSPRN to adjust the size of the printout by changing the font. This may be necessary to ensure that the printout fits correctly on the paper.

The use of DOSPRN allows the Windows LCS to be used on Windows 2000, XP or ME with ANY windows printer.
